

CRITERIA FOR FINANCIAL NEED SCHOLARSHIPS

Send the relevant documentation for your application;

- Bank statements for one year of the person(s) who will be making payments to PERA on behalf of the student.
- Medical reports and letter from doctor for any disability of student's guardians, proof of guardian receiving incapacity or disability allowance.
- Divorce or Death Certificate if guardian is a single parent
- Tax documents listing guardian(s)'s dependents (children) (if applicant has more than three siblings under the age of 18)
- Guardian and applicant's country of residence (include information in your supporting written statement).

Please attach the following academic documents to support your financial need scholarship application:

- A copy of any school certificate(s) prior to undergoing your studies at PERA. (please offer a translated version if the certificate is not in English)
- Transcripts, other documentation of your performance in the subject (dance – theory and practice).
- A written statement outlining why you are eligible for the financial need scholarship and why you should be awarded it (max 250 words)

***Scholarships are valid for one academic year and are calculated based on the programme tuition fees, which are reassessed each academic year.**
